The Judging System

Contestants are evaluated by the three judging categories: Musicality, Performance and Singing as set forth by the society through its International Contest and Judging Committee. Each judge evaluates the overall performance from the perspective of their respective category, as summarized below. However, there is a common ground shared by all categories that the judges use to evaluate the singing and performance skills. The total score should consistently reflect the overall presentation. Each judge awards a score from 0 to 100 for each song. As you evaluate the contestants, keep in mind the following points:

Musicality

The song and arrangement are evaluated as performed, looking for artistic use of the melody, harmony, lyrics, rhythm/meter and form to generate good barbershop music. It rewards performances that fit the abilities of the performers. The major elements in the Musicality Category are consonance, theme, embellishment, execution, delivery and musicality, while preserving the barbershop style.

Performance

The focus is on how the performers bring a song to life and offer it to the audience. This category is designed to measure the degree of entertainment value in terms of effect and believability, including both vocal and visual elements. Techniques that enhance various moments in the song can be used to add value to a phrase, to provide physical motion at a given time, or to use costumes or props to make a point.

Singing

The evaluation of three overall singing skills: singing in tune, vocal quality and ensemble unity, plus the related effects of expanded sound and artistry. Artistic singing glorifies the song, always supporting and never detracting from its message.

Saturday night following the Quartet Finals and Show of Champions the Southeastern Harmony District is hosting a Chordatorium at the Double Tree Hotel. Snacks and beverages will be plentiful as will performances by all of the competing quartets.


At a time when our district is looking forward to our future and its possibilities, consider this...


Southeastern Harmony District **Seniors Chorus**
