Make Your Plans For Leadership Academy in November!

It's time for your chapter to begin compiling its slate of officers for 2013! As you select your officers, speak to them about the importance of attending the District Leadership Academy to help them learn how to effectively fulfill their position in the coming year. Even if they are returning to the same chapter office, there are always new things to learn, new ideas to be shared, new relationships with other chapter officers to build, and new energy and enthusiasm to be developed in helping your chapter move forward!

This year's Academy will take place on Saturday, November 17 at the **Tennessee Technology Center** (TTC) at Nashville from 8:00 am – 5:00 pm. TTC is located at 100 White Bridge Road in West Nashville off of I-40. There will be classes for each chapter officer track, taught by experienced, top-notch instructors from within the District. Every classroom will have audio-visual technology available for instructors who would like to use it. The cost for the Academy is \$50/person. Online registration via the District website will be available no later than September 7.

We have also secured a block of rooms at the **Holiday Inn Express Nashville West** (5612 Lenox Avenue, Nashville, TN 37209), which is only a mile from TTC. The rates are \$89/night for king beds and \$99/night for rooms with two double beds. Reservations can be made by calling (615) 353-0700 or online at www.holidayinnexpress.com/nashvilletn. When making your reservations, reference the Group Code **DDW** (Dixie District Workshop).

Besides the myriad of attractions around Nashville, you will also have the opportunity to attend two holiday shows in town that evening. One will be presented by the **Nashville Singers**, directed by Todd Wilson. The other show will be presented by one of the two top-notch SAI choruses in Nashville, the **Metro Nashville Chorus**. We will have more information about both shows later.

We will communicate much more information in the coming weeks. Hopefully your chapter is making plans to send its chapter officers to the Leadership Academy so that all of you can get a head start on making your plans for a highly successful 2013.
