In addition to being one of the Society's top music arrangers, David is also an avid barbershop harmony historian. He has collected a vast library of audio and video recordings of vocal groups and barbershop quartets during his 37-year barbershop career. David has taken some of those recordings and created a very informative PowerPoint presentation that he uses to present this class. You will listen and watch recordings of international quartet champions and other vocal groups that have helped shape the barbershop harmony style of music. As a master tag teacher, David will periodically teach tags during his presentation.

In addition to David's History of Barbershop class, participants will also be entertained by the 2013 International 3rd Place Quartet A Mighty Wind.
